(EN) This document describes the Welcome Guides for the UNITA Project and its development. These Guides aim, not only to share/promote information about UNITA activities but also, to facilitate the integration and adaptation to the academic life of any participant, in any UNITA Project activity.

(PT) Este documento descreve os Guias de Boas Vindas para o Projeto UNITA e o seu desenvolvimento. Estes guias têm como objetivo, não só partilhar/promover informação sobre as atividades da UNITA, mas também facilitar a integração e a adaptação à vida académica de qualquer participante, em qualquer atividade do Projeto UNITA.

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0. Executive Summary

This document describes the development of the Welcome Guides intended to be provided to UNITA members for ensuring an easy integration and adaptation to each of the institutions of the consortium. In particular, it conveys the details about the strategies used to define a common structure for accommodating the information of the services available at each of the Universities, as well as the major opportunities provided by UNITA. Additionally, the different formats of the Welcome Guides are explained, including the webpage, the printed version, and the promotional video. Finally, the document provides the links to all the content produced as well as the illustrations of the webpage produced comprising the contents of UNITA and all the Universities, which are provided as annexes.

1. Framework

UNITA - *Universitas Montium* is an Alliance between six European Universities, from five different countries, located in mountainous, rural and cross-border regions, and sharing Romance language origin. It aims to build an inspiring European inter-university campus based both on excellence in learning and teaching and on research and innovation for and with the territories.

In order to create an Interuniversity Campus, within UNITA, it is important to develop the digital component, facilitating interaction between participants from the different Universities without the distance obstacle, but it is equally important not to neglect the physical component, interaction and face-to-face contact.

In this sense, and in order to encourage the mobility of students, teachers and non-teachers, increase the social dimension of the campus and support the community, services were identified, and Welcome Guides were created.

2. Method

2.1. Service identification

In an initial phase, a collection of the services provided by each University of the Consortium was carried out. Each Alliance Partner was asked to put in an Excel document, shared on DataCloud, a brief description of the services they had, according to the typology, such as "libraries", "Accommodation", "Volunteer Opportunities", among others, and of the platforms used, according to the categories "Students", "Professors", "Researchers", "Administrative Personnel" and "External to the University".

2.2. Guide collection

Subsequently, and in order to understand how each University shares its information, it was requested, via email, to send Welcome Guides, Reception Guides, Survival Guides, among others, to all Alliance Partners.

The material collected was stored on the DataCloud, at the link: [Universities' Materials - Ficheiros - UniTA Project Datacloud \(univ-unita.eu\)](#).

2.3. Structure

With the information collected from the previous points, a Draft/Proposal of the format and type/content of information for the Guides was prepared. Also, a working group was created with elements from WP2, WP5, WP6, WP8, Internationalization Offices, Welcome Centers and a Student Representative - with whom the document was shared and discussed on various dimensions, namely (i) language of dissemination; (ii) pertinent information; and (iii) definition of the target audience; - whose in-depth knowledge regarding students, academic life and national and international experiences was considered to be an asset for this phase of the project.

Feedback was also requested from the WP leaders, regarding the assertiveness and correctness of the information provided about UNITA.

3. Welcome Guide Design

The Guides are designed in three formats: (i) a webpage, as a place to access in cyberspace; (ii) document, organized as a print-friendly flyer, but primarily as an electronically shareable document, with structured text and images; and (iii) a Welcome video, aimed at a more agile and fast dissemination of information.

3.1 Webpage




Figure 1 - Guide home page

The Guides in *Web* format are available through a UNITA hyperlink [UNITA \(ubi.pt\)](#), where visitors can choose the University they want to see (*Figure 1*). This link is available on the UNITA website ([univ-unita.eu](#)) and on the Virtual Campus website ([UNITA Federal Log In \(uvt.ro\)](#)).

Once inside the selected tab, you will have more detailed information about UNITA (*Figure 2*) as well as from chosen University (*Figure 3*), the latter being available both in English and in the national language of the country of each institution. For more information, context-related hyperlinks are provided throughout the text. Also, the contents of each University are provided in this document as annexes.

A Web application for managing the information on the webpage will be developed in a near future, in order to allow the easy adaptation/update of the information contained on the Web, over time.

Sumário executivo

Este documento descreve o desenvolvimento dos Guias de Boas-Vindas destinados a serem disponibilizados aos membros da UNITA para assegurar uma fácil integração e adaptação a cada uma das instituições do consórcio. Detalha, em particular, as estratégias utilizadas para definir uma estrutura comum de acomodação da informação dos serviços disponíveis em cada uma das Universidades, bem como as principais oportunidades oferecidas pela UNITA. Além disso, são explicados os diferentes formatos dos Guias de Boas-Vindas, incluindo a página web, a versão impressa e o vídeo promocional. Por fim, o documento disponibiliza os links para todos os conteúdos produzidos, bem como as ilustrações da página web produzida que integra os conteúdos da UNITA e de todas as Universidades, que são disponibilizados em anexo.

1. Enquadramento

A UNITA - *Universitas Montium* é uma Aliança entre seis Universidades Europeias, de cinco países diferentes, localizadas em regiões montanhosas, rurais e transfronteiriças, e que partilham a língua de origem Românica. Tem como objetivo construir um *campus* interuniversitário europeu inspirador baseado tanto na excelência da aprendizagem e do ensino, quanto na pesquisa e inovação para e com os territórios.

De forma a criar um *Campus* Interuniversitário no âmbito do projeto UNITA, é importante desenvolver a componente digital, facilitadora da interação entre os participantes das diferentes Universidades sem o obstáculo “distância”, mas é igualmente importante não descurar a componente física, a interação e o contacto presencial.

Neste sentido, e de forma a incentivar a mobilidade de estudantes, docentes e não-docentes, aumentar a dimensão social do *campus* e apoiar a comunidade, foram identificados serviços e criados Guias de Boas-Vindas.

2. Etapas

2.1. Identificação de serviços

Numa fase inicial, foi feita uma recolha dos serviços disponibilizados por cada Universidade do Consórcio. Foi solicitado que cada Parceiro da Aliança colocasse num documento *Excel*, partilhado na *DataCloud*, uma breve descrição dos serviços de que dispunham, segundo a tipologia, como por exemplo “bibliotecas”, “Acomodações”, “Oportunidades de Voluntariado”, entre outros, e das plataformas utilizadas, de acordo com as categorias “Estudantes”, “Professores”, “Investigadores”, “Pessoal Administrativo” e “Externo à Universidade”.

2.2. Recolha de Guias

Posteriormente, e de forma a perceber a forma como cada Universidade disponibiliza a sua informação, foi solicitado, via email, o envio de Guias de Boas-Vindas, Guias de Acolhimento e Guias de Sobrevivência, entre outros, a todos os Parceiros da Aliança.

2.3. Estrutura

Com a informação recolhida nos pontos anteriores, foi elaborado um Rascunho/Proposta do formato e tipo/conteúdo de informação para os Guias. Foi ainda criado um grupo de trabalho com elementos do WP2, WP5, WP6, WP8, Gabinetes de Internacionalização, Centros de Acolhimento e a Representante dos Estudantes - com os quais o documento foi partilhado e discutido sobre várias dimensões, designadamente (i) linguagem de disseminação; (ii) informação pertinente; e (iii) definição do público-alvo - cujo conhecimento aprofundado no que respeita aos estudantes, à vida académica e às experiências nacionais e internacionais se considerou ser uma mais-valia para esta fase do projeto.

Foi ainda solicitado parecer, aos líderes dos WPs responsáveis, relativamente à assertividade e correção da informação disponibilizada sobre a UNITA.

3. Formato do Guia de Boas-Vindas

Os Guias são concebidos em três formatos: (i) uma Página Web, como um local ao qual aceder no ciberespaço; (ii) documento, organizado como um panfleto amigável à impressão, mas principalmente como um documento partilhável eletronicamente, com texto estruturado e imagens; e (iii) um vídeo de Boas-Vindas, visando uma divulgação de informação mais ágil e movimentada.

3.1 Página Web

Os Guias em formato Web estão disponíveis através de uma hiperligação [UNITA \(ubi.pt\)](#), onde o visitante poderá optar pela Universidade que deseja conhecer (*Figura 1*). Esta hiperligação está disponível na Página Web da UNITA ([univ-unita.eu](#)) e na Página Web do Campus Virtual ([UNITA Federal Log In \(uvt.ro\)](#)).





Figura 1 - Página inicial do Guia



1. Résumé

Ce document décrit l'élaboration des guides d'accueil destinés à être fournis aux membres de UNITA pour assurer une intégration et une adaptation aisées à chacune des institutions du consortium. En particulier, il donne des détails sur les stratégies utilisées pour définir une structure commune pour accueillir l'information des services disponibles dans chacune des universités, ainsi que les principales opportunités offertes par UNITA. De plus, les différents formats des guides de bienvenue sont expliqués, y compris la page Web, la version imprimée et la vidéo promotionnelle. Enfin, le document fournit les liens vers tous les contenus produits, ainsi que les illustrations de la page Web produite comprenant le contenu de UNITA et de toutes les universités, qui sont fournies en annexe.

1. Modèle

UNITA - *Universitas Montium* est une alliance de six universités européennes, de cinq pays différents, situées dans des régions montagneuses, rurales et transfrontalières, et partageant l'origine de la langue romane. Elle vise à construire un campus interuniversitaire européen inspirant fondé à la fois sur l'excellence dans l'apprentissage et l'enseignement, et sur la recherche et l'innovation pour et avec les territoires.

Afin de créer un Campus Interuniversitaire, au sein de UNITA, il est important de développer la composante numérique, facilitant l'interaction entre les participants des différentes Universités sans l'obstacle de la distance, mais il est également important de ne pas négliger la composante physique, l'interaction et le face-à-face - contact facial.

En ce sens, et afin de favoriser la mobilité des étudiants, enseignants et non enseignants, d'augmenter la dimension sociale du campus et de soutenir la communauté, des services ont été identifiés et des guides d'accueil ont été créés.

2. Méthode

2.1. Identification du Service

Dans une première phase, une collecte des services fournis par chaque Université du Consortium a été réalisée. Il a été demandé à chaque partenaire de l'Alliance de mettre dans un document Excel, partagé sur DataCloud, une brève description des services dont il disposait, selon la typologie, tels que «bibliothèques», «Hébergement», «Opportunités de bénévolat», entre autres, et des plateformes utilisées, selon les catégories «Étudiants», «Professeurs», «Chercheurs», «Personnel administratif» et «Externe à l'Université».

2.3. Structure

Avec les informations recueillies aux points précédents, une ébauche/proposition du format et du type/contenu des informations pour les guides a été préparée. En outre, un groupe de travail a été créé avec des éléments du WP2, WP5, WP6, WP8, des bureaux d'internationalisation, des centres d'accueil et un représentant des étudiants - avec qui le document a été partagé et discuté sur diverses dimensions, à savoir (i) la langue de diffusion ; (ii) des informations pertinentes ; et (iii) la définition du public cible ; - dont la connaissance approfondie des étudiants, de la vie universitaire et des expériences nationales et internationales a été considérée comme un atout pour cette phase du projet.

3. Design du Guide de Bienvenue

Les guides sont conçus en trois formats : (i) une page Web, comme lieu d'accès dans le cyberspace ; (ii) un document, organisé comme un dépliant imprimable, mais principalement comme un document partageable électroniquement, avec du texte et des images structurés ; et (iii) une vidéo de bienvenue, visant à une diffusion plus agile et rapide de l'information.

3.1 Webpage




Figure 1 - Page d'accueil du guide

Les Guides en format Web sont disponibles à travers un lien UNITA [UNITA \(ubi.pt\)](#), où les visiteurs peuvent choisir l'Université qu'ils souhaitent voir (*Figure 1*). Cette liaison est disponible sur le website UNITA ([univ-unita.eu](#)) et également sur le website du Campus Virtuel ([UNITA Federal Log In \(uvt.ro\)](#)).




Figure 2 - Contenu UNITA

Une fois dans l'onglet sélectionné, des informations plus détaillées sur UNITA apparaîtront (*Figure 2*) ainsi que sur l'université choisie (*Figure 3*), cette dernière étant disponible à la fois en anglais et dans la langue nationale du pays de chaque institution. Pour plus d'informations, des hyperliens contextuels sont fournis tout au long du texte. En outre, le contenu de chaque université est fourni dans ce document sous forme d'annexes.

0. Rezumat

Acest document descrie dezvoltarea Ghidurilor de Bun Venit cu scopul distribuirii lor membrilor UNITA în scopul asigurării unei adaptări și integrări ușoare la fiecare dintre instituțiile consorțiului. În mod special, prevede detaliile privitoare la strategiile utilizate să definească o structură comună pentru asimilarea serviciilor de informații puse la dispoziție de fiecare Universitate, precum și oportunitățile majore oferite de UNITA. În plus, diferențele formate ale Ghidurilor sunt explicate, inclusiv pagina Web, versiunea tipărită și videoclipul promovațional. În ultimul rând, documentul prevede link-uri către tot conținutul creat precum și ilustrațiile paginilor web create, cuprinzând conținuturile UNITA respectiv conținuturile universităților partenere, prevăzute ca anexe ale prezentului document.

1. Cadru

UNITA-Universitas Montium este o Alianță formată din șase Universități Europene, din cinci țări diferite, localizate în regiuni montane, rurale și trans-frontaliere, având în comun originea Latină a limbilor vorbite. Alianța își propune să construiască un campus European inter-universitar inspirațional bazat atât pe excelență în învățare și predare cât și pe inovare cu și pentru teritori.

Pentru a realiza un campus Inter-universitar în cadrul UNITA este importantă dezvoltarea componentei digitale, facilitarea interacțiunii dintre participanții diferitelor Universități, depășind obstacolul distanței fizice fără a neglija componenta fizică, interacțiunea și contactul față în față.

În acest scop și pentru a încuraja mobilitatea studenților, profesorilor și personalului administrativ, pentru a sublinia dimensiunea socială a campusului și pentru a sprijini comunitatea, serviciile au fost identificate și Ghidurile de Bun Venit s-au realizat.

2. Metoda

2.1. Identificarea serviciilor

Fiecarei universități Partenere i-a fost solicitată completarea unui tabel Excel distribuit pe DataCloud cu o scurtă descriere a serviciilor de care dispune, conform tiparului, precum "biblioteci", "cazare", "Oportunități de Voluntariat", printre altele, și a platformelor utilizate, conform categoriilor "Studenți", "Profesori", "Cercetători", "Personal Administrativ" și "Membru extern".

2.2. Colectarea Ghidurilor




Figure 1 - Guide home page





Figure 2 - UNITA Content




Figura 1 - Home page della guida




Figure 2 - UNITA Content

1. Contexto

UNITA - *Universitas Montium* es una Alianza entre seis Universidades europeas, de cinco países diferentes, ubicadas en regiones montañosas, rurales y transfronterizas, y que comparten la lengua de origen romance. Su objetivo es construir un *campus* interuniversitario europeo inspirador basado tanto en la excelencia del aprendizaje y de la enseñanza, como en la investigación y la innovación para y con los territorios.




Figura 1 - Guía de la página de inicio




Figure 4 - Webpage Home Page



The [university Savoie Mont Blanc](#) is located in two French areas (Savoie and Haute-Savoie), in the region Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes. Canteens

USMB counts 3 to 4 university restaurants on each campus. They are open Monday to Friday from 8 am to 2pm. Only a few offer evening meals: Pizzeria Hélice and La Chautagne on the Bourget-du-Lac campus. There is no food service on weekends. A complete lunch composed of a starter, a main dish and cheese or dessert costs 3,30 € for a student and 1 € for students receiving a scholarship granted on social grounds.

In addition, you will find cafeterias on campuses, offering: lunch menus (a sandwich, a drink, a yogurt or a fruit) and a breakfast menu (a hot drink, a croissant, bread with butter and jam and orange juice).

Accommodation for UNITA guests can be provided in UVT [dormitories](#) situated in the student area and in the city ([See map](#)).

Students can be accommodated in UVT dormitories with double rooms (shared bathroom), triple rooms (private bathroom), 4 or 5 beds rooms (shared bathroom) and with a series of facilities (internet, cable TV, laundry facilities, study rooms, shared kitchen etc.), at a student-friendly budget.

Another option is to rent a flat in the city. This option is more expensive, the average cost for a two rooms apartment is around 300 euro/month, but this depends according to the location (more central = more expensive).

For short-term visits, UNITA guests can also opt for a hotel. As the university is located within walking distance from the city centre, any variant of a hotel in the central area of Timișoara would be an adequate option.

Canteens

Within and around the university there are a number of food options available:

In the university's main building there is a buffet dedicated to serving food. It has the advantage of being positioned within the university, which allows you to enjoy a meal between classes or before going to your accommodation.

Right across the street from UVT main building, you can enjoy a drink or a meal at a variety of bistros and restaurants and mingle with the locals in Timișoara.

Comidas

Canteens

If you feel hungry, there are canteens in almost every faculty. They are open from 8:00 to 20:00 on labour days, and they serve snacks and hot and soft drinks. The main meal (lunch) is served from 13:00 to 15:00, and those who acquire a voucher will get a discount.

Common areas with microwave oven service are available if you prefer to bring your food. There are also soft drink and snack vending machines in almost all the university buildings and centers.
