

moving to linked data

- moving from static HTML to dynamic, responsive site
- introducing linked data to power content aggregations around related topics
- starting to embed linked open data in every page as RDFa
- using the IPTC rNews vocabulary to describe contnet in a machine-readable way

impact on journalists

- annotating ("tagging")content with topics
- tool embedded into existingCMS
- concept extraction/NLP for topic suggestion
- journalists accept/reject suggested topics for annotation





pilot - publishing RDFa

- using RDFa + rNews to embed machinereadable metadata in article source code
- discoverability: rich snippets + better ranking
- publish Linked Open Data:
 <articleURI> rdf:type rnews:Article
 <articleURI> rnews:about <thingURI> etc...






