### **POLICY MAKING**



Our official **Open Science policy** regulates general principles, is aligned with the UNESCO recommendation and the Italian National Plan on Open Science and settles a common framework for all the departments. It also represents a reference for the local regulations for FAIR data management, diamond and green open access. An **Open Science committee** is responsible for the dissemination of Open Science principles within the University.

#### **PLATFORMS**



In 2021 we launched the **TESeO platform**, based on the latest OJS version, hosting all scientific journals published by UniTrento under a diamond Open Access policy.

In 2023 we launched a **Zenodo public community** to keep track of our official documents on Open Science, such as the policy, regulations and periodic reports.

# TRAINING & NETWORKING



We annually offer to our research staff and students **courses** on open access, transformative agreements and research data management.

Trento is official member and / or participates to the main national initiatives of the Italian Association on Open Science (AISA), the Italian Computing and Data Infrastructure (ICDI) and the Italian Reproducibility Network (ITRN).
