  - e.g. Medical Device Regulation

# About CEN

- The European Committee for Standardization
  - *Comité Européen de Normalisation*
  - Brings together National Standardization Bodies from 34 European countries
  - Is one of three European Standardisation Organizations, together with
    - CENELEC – Electrotechnical
    - ETSI – Telecommunications
  - Responsible for European Standards that can be used to support EU legislation and policies

# Scope & mission

- CEN/TC 251 ‘Health informatics’ = information engineering applied to the domain of health
- Members: having a strategic and responsible position in the standards arena in the EU and affiliated countries including the United Kingdom, Norway, and Switzerland.
- Mirroring & cooperating closely with ISO/TC 215 ‘Health informatics’.
- Active member as one of the thirteen members of the Joint Initiative Council for Global Health Informatics Standardization (JIC). Part of the vision is to achieve widespread adoption and use of harmonized health informatics standards, where a singular set of standards is recognized as addressing each health business need.

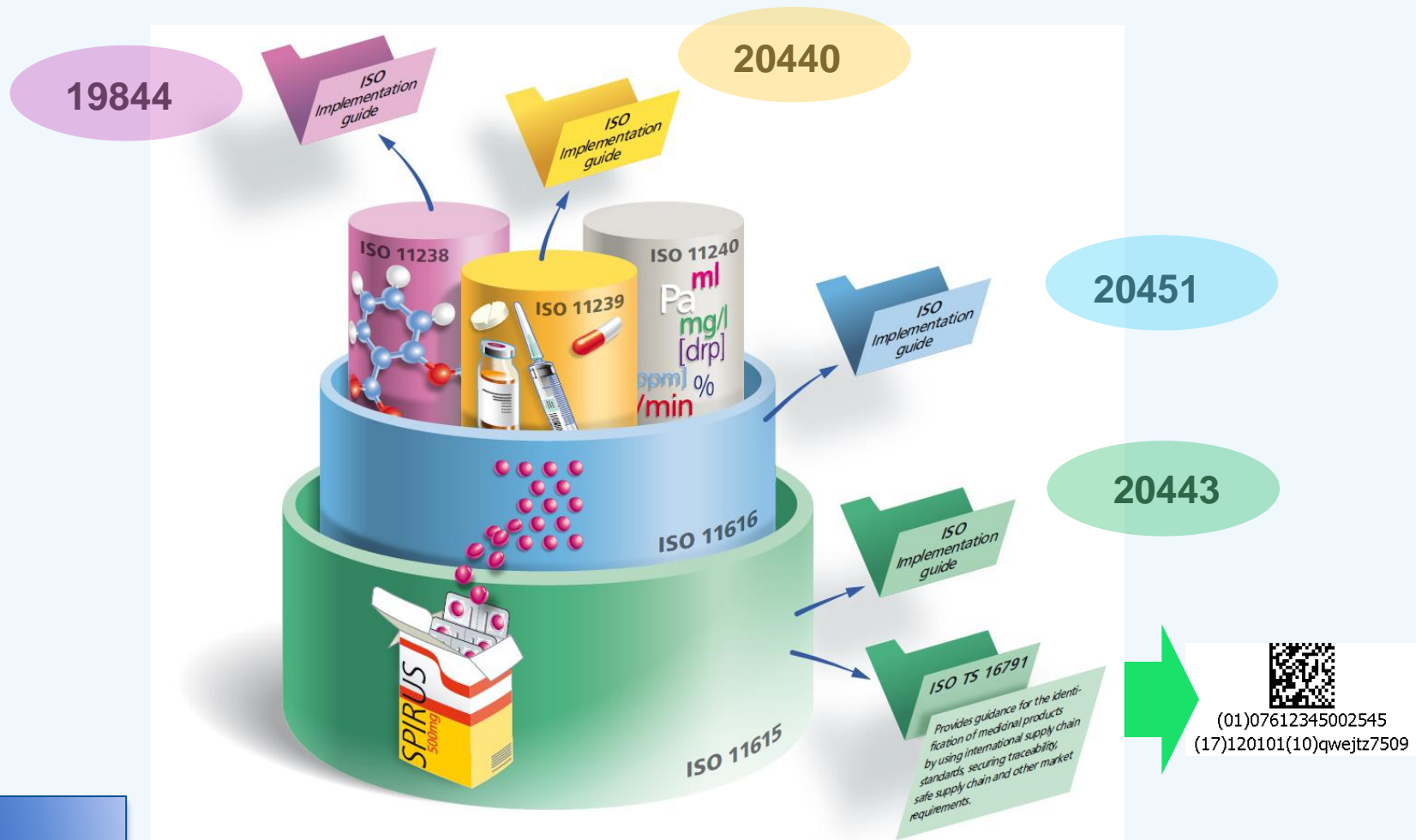
Very broad range of topics and types of standards, such as:

- Requirements (functional, privacy, security, technical) and data models
- Classifications, systems of concepts, representation of clinical knowledge
- Quality and reliability of processes and products
- Architecture and interoperability specs, including device communication

# Three key examples

- Identification of Medicinal Products – IDMP
  - To be used across the landscape of medicinal product regulation and use
- International Patient Summary – IPS
  - To be used in (un)planned encounters outside of the “home” health system
- Quality and Reliability of Health and Wellness Apps
  - To be used for both patients, providers and authorities for assessing the quality and reliability of apps

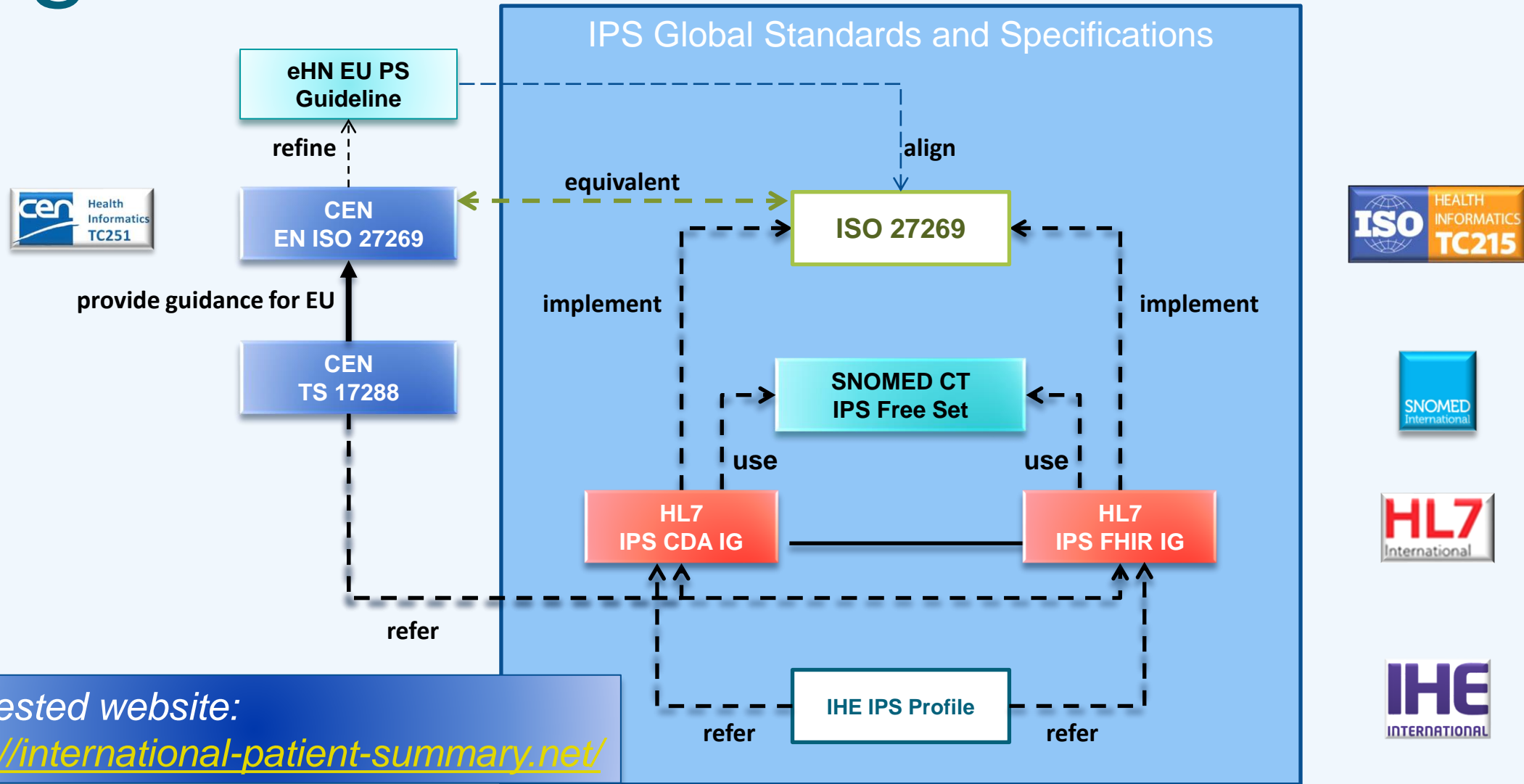
# IDMP – a visual representation



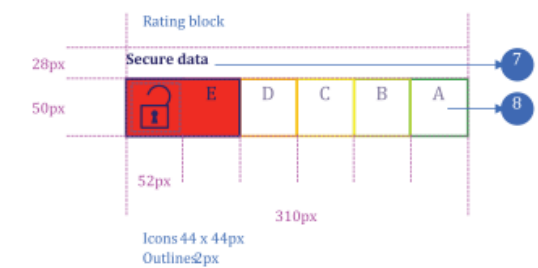
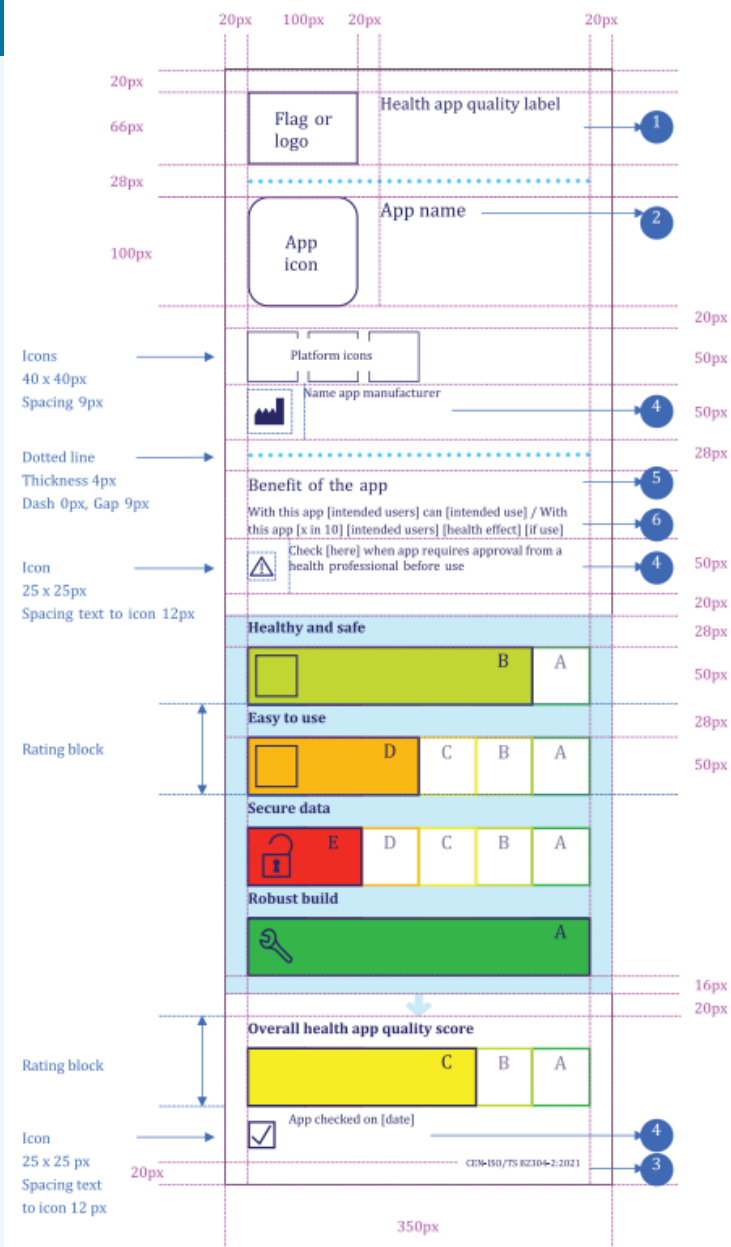
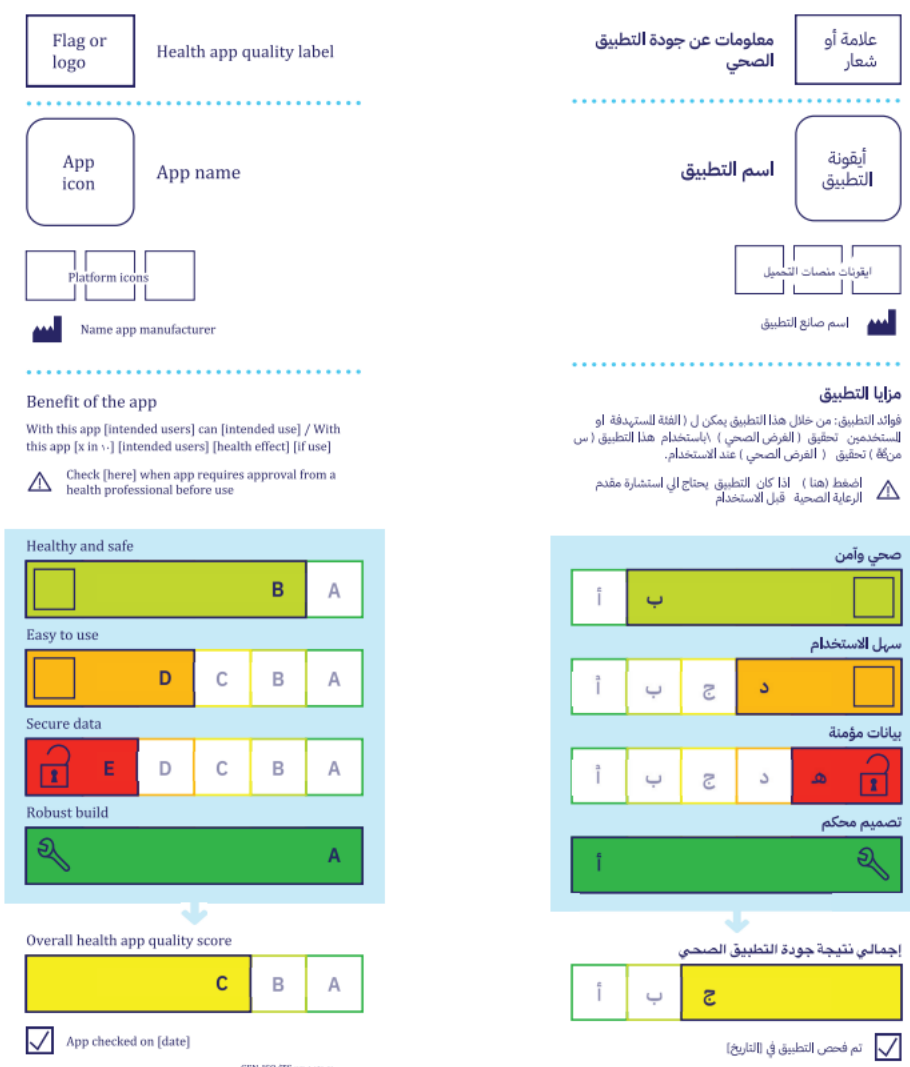
