

# 3.2. ICONICITY + TWO HANDS = SIMULTANEOUS FORM FOR SIMULTANEOUS EVENTS

'I looked at the person as she walked over beside me.'



'I (asked her)
What do you want"?"

#### CORE UNIVERSALS

- Symbolization of objects, actions, ideas
- Combinatoriality of language units: Sounds, words, phrases, and sentences combine and recombine with other units of the same kind to produce a potentially infinite number of interpretable expressions.
- Iconic, simultaneous expressions of the body
