

Outcomes of the discussions with stakeholders

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Bilateral discussions with key EU stakeholders, what for?

- Last opportunity to discuss uptake of main results produced by the One Health EJP
- Cross-check information by having the opportunity of undertaking transparent discussions with each stakeholder separately
- Discuss concrete ways, concrete further actions to take in the near and mid-term future

Bilateral discussions with key EU stakeholders, who, when?

- **Target EU stakeholders only**, national stakeholders (Ministries) is the duty of each partner institutes of each participating country, (through national mirror groups for instance)
- 7 stakeholders targetted, all part of the stakeholder committee managed by WP5 (we know them and they know the One Health EJP well already).
- Namely:
 - EFSA – 28 June
 - ECDC – 23 August
 - EEA – 29 August
 - JRC – 6 September
 - DG SANTE – 7 September
 - FAO – 31 August
 - WHO-EU – planned 8 September but postponed to later on



Bilateral discussions with key EU stakeholders, principles

- To summarise main achievements of integrative and research projects in a general way (not into details)
- To make tailor-made propositions of next collaborations
- To seek support by stakeholders for next funding opportunities
- To advocate for a next EU funding
- Expected to be a process that takes time (many persons, many layers)



Bilateral discussions with key EU stakeholders, outcomes


- We are going to continue to talk together:
 - A narrow down process: current bilateral discussions aim in a first instance at raising awareness towards high level staff and then go into more details.
 - **EFSA/ECDC/EEA** each have supported the idea to be **invited to a next "cross agency task force" meeting**.
 - Objective: identify precise outputs and put into contact targeted EFSA scientists with the OHEJP ones for concrete uptake by EU agencies of tools produced.
 - **JRC** proposes to jointly **identify priority areas pathogens**
 - **FAO** have proposed to push for **interactions** in the future with the **One Health High level expert panel** (e.g. To agree with the quadripartite on topics for a "community of practice")
 - Objective: One Health EJP to participate to the operationalisation of One Health by being connected with FAO people working for One Health



Bilateral discussions with key EU stakeholders, outcomes

- We are going to continue to collaborate together:
 - FAO and JRC has proposed several track for uptake of the One Health EJP
 - To use the One Health monitoring tool developed by MATRIX (**OH EpiCap Tool**)
 - To use the harmonised laboratory protocols/methodologies developed by OH-Harmony CAP (**OH LabCap**)
 - ECDC/EFSA have already appointed scientists that followed implementation of the integrative and research projects implemented by One Health EJP
 - Tools developed by the One Health EJP can serve for **capacity building actions** to come.
 - **Scientific networks formed by the One Health EJP** can be easily utilised

Bilateral discussions with key EU stakeholders, outcomes

- Stakeholders are going to advocate for the One Health EJP and its sustainability:
 - **JRC** proposes a collaboration agreement to be signed with the  **MED • VET • NET ASSOCIATION**
 - **FAO** has proposed that the One Health EJP be cited in the **2024 hunger negotiations**
 - We discussed with **DG SANTE** the **possibility of advocating for a next EU funding** in the future to go for a third step in our One Health experience. **EEA ECDC and EFSA may help to convince DG RTD**
 - I refer to testimonies that you have heard earlier today, from EFSA ECDC and WHO-EU



Bilateral discussions with key EU stakeholders, conclusions

- **Keep the momentum** by continuing discussing and exchanging with our stakeholders and prepare the future actions of the
- **Continue the dissemination** of tools, data, networks... produced by the One Health EJP
- Look for **optimal uptake by stakeholders**
- Keep the One Health EJP scientific communities present for them (e.g. **capacity building actions in EU MS, but also outside the EU**)
