CLACSO: 898 research centers in 56 countries

- ✓ CLACSO's network institutions publish approx. 400 journals in OA (no APC) and more than 3.000 books in open access (no BPC)
- ✓ CLACSO's repository: 100.000 full texts from member institutes (articles, journals, books, book chapters, research reports, opinions papers, multimedia)
- ✓ Campaign promoting non-commercial open access in Latin America, together with other OA initiatives in the region, and in the world
- ✓ Alliances. With Redalyc-AmeliCA: a joint collection of 1.025 SSH quality journals in open access
- ✓ Grant calls require a description of how and where research outputs will be available in OA.
- ✓ Working Groups: participatory science. Open engagement of societal actors & open dialogue with other knowledge systems.

Platforms for Social Dialogue (PSD)

✓ SIDA-CLACSO alliance: production of evidence-based, critical, situated knowledge with a high impact on the definition of policies, public opinion and the positive transformation of the living conditions of the most impoverished, oppressed and discriminated populations.

What are the main challenges of research assessment reform in IAC?









- **❖CULTURA**L: from excellence to research quality in dialogue with social relevance and social engagement.
- ❖ POLITICAL: align regional evaluation systems (research, careers, institutions) with qualitative evaluation supported by situated quantitative indicators and open science principles and values.
- ❖ INFRAESTRUCTURES: shared, interoperable, federated, interoperable, sustainable, supporting bibliodiversity and multilingualism.
- **COMMUNITIES**: Team science, inclusive and equitable, recognition of diverse career paths and contributions; interdisciplinary approaches.

Transforming Research Assessment for Next Generations



- ✓ Cooperate with comprehensive, articulated and incremental reform of evaluation systems, aligned with open science principles and values.
- ✓ Strengthen and improve the interoperability of open digital infrastructures and reward and recognize open science practices.
- ✓ Move away from the use of bibliometric indicators of journal impact as a criterion of quality.
- ✓ Encourage academic communications oriented towards noncommercial and sustainable models based on collaborative and solidarity-based work.
- ✓ Synergies between FOLEC (LAC) and COARA (EU): participatory and situated reforms aligned with open science. Forums of experiences and learning, transformative laboratories and supranational bodies for coordination and monitoring of actions. Cultural change through the participation of a diversity of academic (especially ECR) and non-academic actors.
