1-3) In the year of the (dynastic) rule of the prosperous Candragupta the *mahārājādhirāja*, an ardent devotee of Bhagavat (Vāsudeva), when this was the specification of the date,

3-7) ... Mātrdāsa, the chief (of the householders) ... for the purpose of augmenting her own spiritual merit) ... organized ... a Brāhmaṇa of the township of Sadāsattra by ten *dīnāras* (or in figures) 10.

8-9) And whosoever (breaks up) this bit of charity shall become infected (with the Five Great Sins).
